USMAA Cricket Competition Rules

| | |
|----|---|
| 1 | Each game shall be played between two (2) teams consisting of six (6) players. A game shall consist of a maximum of five (5) six-ball overs completed by each team |
| 2 | The competition shall initially run on a Round-Robin fixture and then shall be on a Knock out basis |
| 3 | In each of the Round Robin games, the winning team shall get 2 Points and losing team shall get 0 Points. In the event of a Draw, teams shall get 1 point each |
| 4 | In the event of two or more teams in a group obtaining equal number of Points in the top position, a SUPER Over will be given per team in order to decide the winner to advance through the competition. |
| 5 | Underarm bowling is prohibited |
| 6 | A "wide" shall count as one (1) run to the batting team and an extra ball shall be bowled. Over the head height will be called a "wide". Leg-side wide rule will be applicable. |
| 7 | A "no-ball" shall count as one (1) run to the batting team and an extra ball shall be bowled. A full delivery over the waist height will be called a "no ball" |
| 8 | If five wickets fall before five (5) overs are completed, the remaining batsman shall continue with the 5th out batsperson acting as a runner. The remaining batsman shall be declared out if their partner ("runner") is subsequently declared out. The Inning shall be completed at the fall of the sixth wicket. |
| 9 | Two (2) players are allowed to bowl maximum of two (2) overs per bowler in a match |
| 10 | Should a fielder be injured during the course of play, a substitute fielder will be permitted, but he (substitute) will not be allowed to bowl or bat. At bat, the injured player shall be entitled to a "runner" |
| 11 | The side having achieved the highest score at the completion of the match shall be declared the winner |
| 12 | All the team must be ready to take the field as soon as the previous game is completed |
| 13 | Each team may nominate eight (8) players at registration, from which the team of six (6) players shall be selected prior to the first match and shall remain in the same team during the course of the competition. There will be exceptions if a team unable to fill six (6) players |
| 14 | All respective team must be on the grounds on time. If not present on time Umpire will make the decision as Walkover |
| 15 | One player from each team shall be nominated as a team Captain for the competition. Captain shall be responsible for nominating the six players for the competition, batting and bowling orders, for the conduct of the team and acting on behalf of the team in the event of any disputes |
| 16 | All decisions by umpire on the field of play and the Competition Co-ordinators in all matters shall be final. Any player showing unreasonable dissent in the opinion of the umpires shall follow due warning or disqualification from further play in the competition. |
| 17 | All teams are to provide their own bats. |
| 18 | Match balls will be provided by the Competition Co-ordinators |
| 19 | All players are to wear proper runners. No Thongs or barefoot permitted for safety reasons |
| 20 | Match fixtures (who-plays-who) shall be set, in advance, by the organisers on a random-pick basis and shall be communicated to respective team captains before the competition. |
| 21 | If a team fails to turn up, the registration fee will be NOT refunded |
| 22 | USMAA reserves the right to amend these guidelines at any time if it considers such action to be in the best interests of the competition |
